

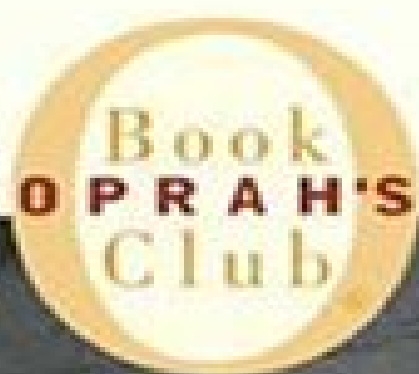

## Resumo de Night
